Based on data from 2019 which cited 40,000 adults experiencing homelessness who are 65+, the projected number of adults 65+ who will be experiencing homelessness will rise to 106,000 by 2030.

As of 2018, there are between 625,000-875,000 individuals experiencing homelessness who are also experiencing disabilities.<sup>2</sup>

How big is the issue?

8.3 million older adults, 65 and over, have a disability that impacts their ability to navigate stairs or thresholds but only 1% of housing, nationwide, features a no-step entryway. This means that the rest of these adults struggle to get into and out of their home on a daily basis. This leads to social isolation and a loss of community engagement. 6



7.2 million older adults have hearing difficulties 7



3.1 million older adults have vision difficulties 7
